Dear Valued Customer,

California Proposition 65 requires manufacturers and suppliers to provide customers notification about chemicals in the products they purchase for them that may contain potentially hazardous materials. The State of California currently has provided a list of over 900 chemicals, including both synthetic and naturally occurring related to Proposition 65. With some exceptions, if a business sells a product in California that contains one or more substances on the Proposition 65 list, then a corresponding warning must be provided.

This letter will confirm steel products sold by West Coast Steel and Processing contain chemicals according to the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65):

WARNING: This product can expose you to chemicals including nickel, which is known to the State of California to cause cancer, and chromium (hexavalent compounds) from welding fumes, which is known to the State of California to cause, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
